B.Authorities:

The University Senate is the chief academic body at the university level and is responsible for coordinating the academic activities of the University.

C.History of University:

Our university has been established with No. 26536 dated 29.05.2007 No. 5662 Law on Organization of Higher Education Institutionsand HigherEducation InstitutionsTeaching Staff rosters with DecreeLaw on the Procedure of the General Staffpublished in the Official Gazette and the schedules attached to the DecreeLaw on the Amendment Article 7 of the 2809 Additional 72nd agentadded Law. Since its establishment in 2007, it continue sits growin geffort making high-quality education. Siirt University, Institute of Education in 1976 as a two-year on the Dicle University was established in 1982 under the name of Siirt Education School education continued at the the level of associated degree programs. College offers under graduate programs in the academic year 1989-1990 opened in 1992, was named Dicle University Faculty of Education.

There are 10 faculties in the university; Education Faculty, Engineering Faculty, Fine Arts and Design Faculty, Science-Literature, Agriculture, Theology Faculty, Faculty of Economics and Administrative sciences and Veterinary Medical Faculty, Medicine Faculty, 4 Institutions: Institute of Science, Social Sciences, Institute of Living Languages and Health Science Institute; 3 Higher Schools: Higher School of Tourism, Higher School of Foreign Languages, School of Physical Education and Sport; 6Vocational Schools: Vocational School of Design, Vocational School of Health Services, Vocational School of Kurtalan, Vocational School of Eruh, Vocational School of Technical Sciences and Vocational School of Social Sciences, 3 Research Centers: Research and Training Center for Crafts, Research and Training Center for Issues of Women and Continuous Training and Research Center.

Central Campus, which is in city centre, Kezer Campus and Kurtalan and Eruh campusesarestill continuing their education and training. In the Central Campus, there is Vocational School of Social Studies. In Eruh Campus, there is The Vocational School of Eruh and in Kurtalan Campus, there is The Vocational School of Kurtalan. And in Kezer Campus, there are The Rectorate Service Buildings, The Faculties of Engineering and Architecture, Science and Literature, Agriculture, Theology are still continuing their education and services. Also, Lab of Central Research, Indoor Sports Halland a Guest House are seen in Kezer Campus.

F.Accomodation:

In Siirt, within the General Directorate of Higher Education Credit and Hostels Institution, with the 840 male-dormitory and 750 female-dormitory, there are student dormitories having capacity at different levels.

In the district vocational high schools, dormitories related to Department of Culture and Sports in the university are available. In Eruh residence Vocational School dormitory has a capacity of 450 students, the dormitory of vocational School of Kurtalan has the capacity of 100 students. State-Run Dormitories:

There are enough places available for students in state-run dormitories.

Private Student Hostels

Private student hostels, under the supervision of Ministry of Education, are a popular second option. They are comfortable and most amenities are provided: central heating, 24 hours hot water, breakfast, dinner, cafeteria, study room, TV Lounge and transfort to campus.

Rented Flats

Renting a flat may offer more freedom but it is not easy to find a house often, though not always, need to buy their own furniture. Flats are not so cheap and affordable, but with several students they can be rented and affodable.

Host Families

It is very rare in Siirt.

G. Meals:

Lunch and dinner are served in the dining halls in the university. Meals are in good quality and cheap with the aim of a balanced diet and are served four-course meal. In addition, student canteens are available in each unit, alternative feeding opportunities are bestowed. In each academic year, students in need of support are given a free meal card by the university.

Lunch and dinner, prepared and planned by specialist dieticians and food engineers, are served in a healthy, orderly manner under hygienic conditions at the canteen on campus with the purpose of meeting the nutrition needs of our students and employees.

H. Transportation:

There are three flights in a week from Siirt Airport and these three flights are made only to Ankara. However, there is Batman Airport an hour away from Siirt and Diyarbakır Airport three hours from Siirt has direct flights to main big towns and also connected flighs to other part of Turkey. Beside airplane, there are buses used for intercity transportation. For intracity transportation, most of the time minibuses are used and they cost 3.50 Turkish Liras. Other than that it is walking distance to almost everywhere most of the time. Basically transportation is pretty easy for students at Siirt.

I.Medical Facilities:

In Kezer Campus, Health, Culture and Sports Department provides health care for our students which is called as "Medico". In addition, our province of Siirt has one state hospital and three private hospitals which provide health care services.

J.Cost of Living:

Estimated living expenses for all international students are around 200-250 Dolars per month, including accommodation and other personal expenses.

K.Visa:

VISA REQUIREMENTS

Please obtain a Student Visa / Education Visa from the nearest Turkish Consulate in your area before you enter Turkey. You can not obtain a Student Visa after you arrive and tourist visa is not acceptable as a substitute.

Important!

If you enter Turkey without having student visa, you need to pay 308 TL extra fee to the police station to get residence permit.

Documents needed:

- ✓ Passport valid at least a year
- ✓ Completed visa application form.
- ✓ Recent passport size photographs
- ✓ Proof of their student status in their home country(Official paper taken from Registrar's Office)
- ✓ The acceptance letter from Siirt University
- ✓ Non-refundable processing fee

Although a time limit will be stamped on your visa, the student visa will be valid as long as you are enrolled in school.

As visa regulations may change quite frequently, please contact the nearest Turkish Embassy or Consulate in your country to obtain the most up-to-date and detailed information.

Visa and Residence Permit

Please contact the Turkish Embassy based in your country to find out what the requirements are for an entrance visa for your travel to Turkey.

You are required to apply for a residence permit in person at the Siirt Police Station within a month of your arrival to Siirt. You will be provided with the necessary documents on arrival.

Please Note: Extension of permits must be applied for no later than 15 days of the expiration date at the Police Station; otherwise a penalty fee will be charged.

Traveling By Air

The most popular airports of the Turkish Republic are "Atatürk Airport" (Istanbul) and "Esenboğa Aiport" (Ankara), which are used during connections to Ankara and then to Siirt. Traveling by Coach/Bus/Train

You also have the choice of traveling by coach/bus to Siirt from all cities in Turkey. It takes up to 24 hours from Istanbul to Siirt and 17 hours from Ankara to Siirt. We have also a train Station in Kurtalan District.

The bus fee is very reasonable and is subject to change.

Taxi/Cab

Not many people use a taxi in the city centre as everything is in walking distance. A taxi from the airport can cost up to 100 Turkish liras.

TURKEY;

SIIRT;

Siirt (Arabic: תִּבֶּעֶר, Siġird; Armenian: Uητηη, Sgherd; Kurdish: Sêrt;) is a a pretty province located in Southeastern Anatolia, 224 km northeast of Mardin, and separated from this province by the Tigris (Dicle) river in southeastern Turkey and the seat of Siirt Province. The province borders Bitlis to the north, Batman to the west, Mardin to the southwest, Şırnak to the south, and Van to the east. Siirt urban center has a mixed population of races. The population of the city according to TSI (Tuik) was 340.528 The provincial capital is Siirt.

Although still one of the poorer cities in Turkey, whole neighborhoods that have fine and modern housing, stores, banks and hotels have been recently built, making Siirt more worthwhile to visit.

This region which once under the hegemonies of the Persians, Romans and Byzantines, was also an important center during in the Abbasid Caliphate era. It was a place of settlement for many civilizations flourished along the Botan stream. The native people are the Hurri and Subarru settled in the area around 3000 BC. It witnessed the Assyrian and Med domination in the 7th century BC, and later that of the Persian Empire, Seleukos Kingdom, Roman and Byzantine Empires and Iran. After forming the stage for struggles among the Mongolians, Eyyubi, Artuklu and Karakoyunlu, it was annexed by the Ottoman Empire in 1514. The name Siirt is believed to derive from "Keert" which meant "city" in Keldani language. The tombs of Veysel Karani and Ismail Hakki form a bridge of history and civilization between the past and our times as pieces of Islamic civilization.

Grand (Ulu) Mosque was built by Mugiziddun Mahmut, the Seljuk Ruler, in 1129. In 1260, Cizre Governor El Mucahit Ishak built some annexes to the original structure. The mosque was restored by the General Directorate of Foundations in 1965. Its pulpit made of walnut wood is exhibited at the Ethnographic Museum in Ankara as one of the finest specimens of Seljuk woodworking. The mosque has a single balcony minaret ornamented with turquoise China work. However, these works can not resist to climatic conditions. The great dome at the centre is surrounded by smaller domes. The mosque which is the city's landmark, has been restored in 1965.

Siirt is famous around Turkey for its hand-made blankets (Siirt battaniyesi). Many visitors find themselves departing with one offered as a present. The traditional kilims produced by the Jirikan clan (asiret) and revived since 1996 through joint efforts involving official instances and citizens are also much prized. Another product of interest is the Bittim soaps proper to the region. Siirt also has an extremely rich culinary and spa culture. Depending district centers of Aydınlar (former Assyrian-rooted name was Tillo) with its historical medrese is renowned as a religious center and Pervari for its honey based on the particularly rich flora. The city had a significant importance on culture tourism with GAP Project in the area and it is one of the city of Eastern Turkey which needs to be discovered and explored by tourist with it's thermal spas, churches, mosques and with it's tombs. Most of the historical artifacts and buildings which available still for visit from the Seliuk

Not only Botan creek provides available courses and opportunities for rafting and Kano but a bunch of sport activities in area such as hunting, sportive fishing, trekking, paragliding, mountain climbing and camping are only some of the important sport activities available in thiscity.

Botan Caves is one of the most famous caves of Siirt City which was constituted because of the geologic limestone structure of the nature. The limestone is not resistant to water therefore after it melts it gets in a form of cave, and some of those caves along the valley were used as houses.

Billoris Springs are on Siirt-Eruh highway. Its 35 centigrade hot water comes in from a cave on the Botan brook and makes a pool. Calcium bicarbonate and sulphurous hydrogen make this water undrinkable but valuable in healing rheumatism and some skin diseases.

6 kms from Siirt is Aydinlar, a beautiful town where the Ibrahim Hakki Mausoleum Complex stands, with the private Ibrahim Hakki Astronomical Museum nearby. The tomb of Sheik Ismail Fakirullah is another significant religious site, beside the many others.

The province extends over an area of 5,406 square kilometers. The Tigris river and its tributaries constitute its water network. The province has 6 administrative districts (Aydinlar, Baykan, Eruh, Kurtalan, Pervari and Sirvan) and 271 villages.

Textile and copper works are the traditional handicrafts of the city. Its goat wool blankets woven with geometric designs and dyed by natural plants have high value internationally.

The province is rich in terms of its animal population and therefore has a high potential for the development of integrated meat and leather processing industries. It can also move towards woodworks with its forested area of 700,000 hectares. The province has also high potential in promoting its pistachio and vegetable culture. Finally, Siirt is well endowed with asphalt, copper and chrome reserves.
